Edmund Rice Action Camps started in Cork in August 1998.

Two-fold aim:

- To empower young adults to work together providing recreational opportunities for children.
- To be good role models for children who need a break for one reason or another.

All the leaders participate in a training programme which includes workshops in arts and craft and games run by past pupils of Coláiste an Spioraid Naoimh. A mandatory child protection course is completed by all leaders prior to the commencement of the Camp. The children are at the heart of everything that happens on the Camp and the leaders encourage them to get involved in every activity.

On the last day of the Camp, each child is presented with a beautiful certificate and her/his leader outlines to the whole group the special contribution that child made to the Camp.

The Camp concludes with the leaders and children displaying their dancing, singing and musical talents.

The Camp could not happen all over the years without the extraordinary support of the Presentation Brothers, principals, members of staff (past and present) of Coláiste an Spioraid Naoimh and Greenmount Primary School.
